A public hearing will be held at 6:00 P.M., September 18, 2023 at the Kearney Fire Station at which time citizens may be heard on the property tax rates proposed to be set by the Kearney Fire and Rescue Protection District, a political subdivision. The tax rates shall be set to produce the revenues which the budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2024, shows to be required by the current assessed valuation. The result is multiplied by 100 so the tax rate will be expressed in cents per \$100 valuation.
